Dear TPAdvantage, Inc.:

The Kansas Department of Insurance (“Department”) did not receive the 2024 Annual Report as required by K.S.A. 40-3814(a). On July 26, 2024, the Department sent a letter electronically and by mail imposing a statutory penalty because of TPAdvantage, Inc.’s (“Company”) failure to file the annual report. The Department did not receive the imposed penalty. Rather, the Department’s July 26, 2024 letter was returned, unable to forward. The email address on file, awalters@polsinelli.com, showed that the message was “delivered”.

The Department’s subsequent research indicates that your Company’s license in the domicile state of Delaware has expired, effective June 30, 2024. K.S.A. 40-3815 gives the Commissioner authority to revoke your third party administrator’s license if you have violated any provision of chapter 40 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated. K.S.A. 40-3813(b) requires a nonresident third party administrator to have an active license in the Company’s home state.

Accordingly, pursuant to K.S.A. 40-3815, the Department hereby revokes the license of TPAdvantage, Inc. If this action is in error, please contact the Department within the next fourteen (14) days.
