SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

(Pursuant to K.S.A. 40-4909 and K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*)

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") by K.S.A. 40-4909 and K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Commissioner hereby **REVOKES** of the Kansas resident insurance producer's license of **ANTONIO CANNON** ("Respondent"). This Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period if no request for a hearing is made.

Findings of Fact

1. Respondent was licensed as a Kansas nonresident insurance producer on July 28, 2020, and expires December 31, 2025.
2. Respondent's address of record listed on file with the Kansas Department of Insurance ("Department") is [REDACTED] Avon, IN 46123-[REDACTED]
3. On July 28, 2020, a Kansas nonresident insurance producer license application ("Initial application") was submitted to the Department on behalf of the Respondent. On the initial application for licensure, the Respondent answered "No" to Question 1a of the Background Questions on the Application which asks, "Have you been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a misdemeanor?" Due to the negative answers on the background questions on the application, the application was automatically processed and the license was approved.

4. On March 3, 2022, a Kansas nonresident renewal insurance producer application was submitted on behalf of the Respondent. On this renewal application, the Respondent disclosed misdemeanor matters and uploaded documentation to the NIPR Attachments Warehouse as to that matter. In April of 2022, Respondent uploaded documents related to 2001 misdemeanor convictions for Resisting Arrest and Simple Possession of Marijuana in a Mississippi Justice Court. This matter should have been disclosed on Respondent's initial application.

5. In December of 2022, cell phone screenshots of a docket sheet were uploaded by the Respondent in reference to pending misdemeanor charge of battery under a diversion agreement. This misdemeanor occurred on or about May 16, 2021, in the Hendricks Superior Court 4, Indiana, Case Number 32D04-2106-CM-000589. On February 9, 2023, this matter was dismissed after completion of the diversion. Proof of dismissal and the diversion agreement were uploaded on February 20, 2025.

6. On February 20, 2025, Respondent submitted an application ("LOA application") to add lines of authority to the Kansas nonresident insurance producer license. Respondent answered "Yes" to Question 1a of the Background Questions on the Application which asks, "Have you been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a misdemeanor, which has not been previously reported to this insurance department?" Respondent disclosed a pending misdemeanor charge of battery in the Madison Circuit Court 3, Indiana, Case Number 48C03-2412-CM-003639, occurring on August 25, 2024.

7. The Department sent an inquiry letter to the Respondent requesting additional documentation including resolution documents for the pending charge. Respondent provided a

diversion agreement for this matter entered into on April 16, 2025. The diversion agreement is to last until October 16, 2025.

8. Upon the Department's review of the documentation uploaded in the NIPR Attachments Warehouse and that submitted in connection with applications, the Department finds that based on the failure to disclose misdemeanor convictions on the initial application as well as two recent misdemeanors in the applicant's background for the charges of battery, that the insurable interests are no longer served by the Respondent's license.

Applicable Law

K.S.A. 40-4909(a)(1) provides:

The Commissioner may deny, suspend, revoke or refuse renewal of any license issued under this act if the commissioner finds that the applicant or license holder has provided incorrect, misleading, incomplete or untrue information in the license application.

K.S.A. 40-4909(b) provides:

The Commissioner may deny, suspend, revoke or refuse renewal of any license issued under this act if the Commissioner finds that the interests of the insurer or the insurable interests of the public are not properly served under such license.

Policy Reasons

1. It is in the public interest that the license of a producer who has provided incorrect, misleading, incomplete or untrue information in the license application process be revoked.

2. It is in the public that the license of a producer who has been placed into two diversions for recent charges of battery and is currently under court supervision be revoked.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over **ANTONIO CANNON** as well as the subject matter of this proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 40-4909(a) and (b), the Commissioner finds that the insurable interests of the public are no longer properly served under the Kansas nonresident insurance producer's license of **ANTONIO CANNON**.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 40-4909(a) and (b), the Commissioner concludes that sufficient grounds exist for revocation of the Kansas nonresident insurance producer's license of **ANTONIO CANNON**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE THAT:

1. The Kansas nonresident insurance producer's license of **ANTONIO CANNON** is hereby **REVOKED** the effective date of this Order.

2. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **ANTONIO CANNON** shall **CEASE** and **DESIST** from the sale, solicitation or negotiation of insurance in Kansas and/or receiving compensation deriving from the sale, solicitation or negotiation of insurance in Kansas conducted after the effective date of this Order.

NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

ANTONIO CANNON, within fifteen (15) days of service (plus 3 additional days for service by mail) of this Summary Order, you shall file with the Kansas Department of Insurance a written request for hearing on this Summary Order, as provided by K.S.A. 77-542. Any costs incurred as a result of conducting any administrative hearing shall be assessed against the producer/agency who is the subject of the hearing as provided by K.S.A. 40-4909(g). Costs shall include witness fees, mileage allowances, any costs associated with reproduction of documents which become part of the hearing record, and the expense of making a record of the hearing.

If a hearing is not requested, this Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day (with an additional three (3) days for service by mail) period for requesting a hearing. The Final Order will constitute final agency action on the matter.
