**ORDER OF REVOCATION
ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION**

This is to notify you that your Kansas nonresident insurance producer license is **REVOKED** due to the absence of a resident insurance producer license in the home state of Minnesota.

The information provided to the Kansas Department of Insurance (“Department”) reflects that while you relocated to Minnesota in 2024. Upon notification of that state move, the Department switched your Kansas resident insurance producer license to a nonresident insurance producer license, as of August 21, 2024. It has come to the Department’s attention that you have failed to obtain a resident insurance producer license in your new home state and as such, you no longer qualify for a Kansas nonresident insurance producer license.

K.S.A. 40-4909(a)(2)(A) grants the Commissioner of Insurance (“Commissioner”) authority to revoke your insurance producer’s license if you have violated any provision of chapter 40 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated. K.S.A. 40-4906 requires a nonresident insurance agent to be currently licensed and in good standing as a resident insurance agent in the person’s home state. Since you no longer hold a license in your home state as it was surrendered and is no longer active, you no longer qualify for a nonresident license, thus your Kansas Nonresident Insurance Producer License is hereby revoked.

This revocation constitutes an administrative action which you will be required to disclose on all future licensing applications. You may also be required to report this administrative action to any other state where you are currently licensed, in accordance with the requirements of each state.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE THAT:

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 40-4909, the Kansas Nonresident Insurance Producer license of **CONNOR JONES** is hereby **REVOKED**.

2. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **CONNOR JONES** shall **CEASE** and **DESIST** from the sale, solicitation or negotiation of insurance in Kansas and/or receiving

compensation deriving from the sale, solicitation or negotiation of insurance in Kansas conducted after the effective date of this Order.

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NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

You have a right to a hearing before the Assistant Commissioner of Insurance on this Order of Revocation. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542, within fifteen (15) days (plus an additional three days for service by mail) of the date of this letter, you must submit a written request for a hearing. A Hearing Request Form you must use for requesting a hearing is enclosed/attached. The Hearing Request Form must be submitted to:

If you request a hearing, the Kansas Department of Insurance will serve notice of the time and place of the hearing and information on procedures, right of representation, and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of the hearing. Any costs incurred as a result of conducting any administrative hearing shall be assessed against the agent/agency who is the subject of the hearing as provided by K.S.A. 40-4909(g).

If a hearing is not requested, this letter shall become effective as a Final Order, without further notice, upon the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period for requesting a hearing. The Final Order will constitute final agency action in the matter.

In the event you file a petition for judicial review with the District Court, the agency officer designated pursuant to K.S.A. 77-613(e) to receive service of a petition for judicial review on behalf of the Kansas Insurance Department is:
