

## TAX CLEARANCE INFORMATION

As part of the process of reviewing your application for a resident insurance producer license, the Kansas Insurance Department (Department) verifies background question #4 on your application:

- Background Question #4: Have you been notified by any jurisdiction to which you are applying of any delinquent tax obligation that is not the subject of a repayment agreement?

To verify answers to Question # 4, the Kansas Insurance Department contacts the Kansas Department of Revenue (KDOR) to obtain a tax clearance for all applicants.

A Certificate of Tax Clearance indicates that an applicant is currently in compliance with applicable Kansas tax laws.

Tax clearance requests are sent to KDOR by the Department upon the submission of an application. When the Department is notified that KDOR is **unable** to issue a tax clearance for an applicant, the Department notifies the applicant to contact KDOR to resolve any issue preventing the issuance of a tax clearance. **It is the applicant's responsibility to contact KDOR to resolve any issue preventing the issuance of a tax clearance.**

Applications are valid for one year from the date of submission. Tax clearances not received during the time an application is valid will result in the application being closed.
