Kansas Department of Insurance announces cease and desist order for Smith General Ventures, LLC

Topeka, Kan. – Kansas Insurance Commissioner Vicki Schmidt, today, announced that the Securities Division has entered a cease-and-desist order against Nathaniel L. Smith, of Wichita, and Smith General Ventures, LLC for alleged violations of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act (KUSA).

The order prohibits Smith General Ventures, LLC from acting as an investment adviser in Kansas unless properly registered under the KUSA. Smith is prohibited from acting as an investment adviser representative unless registered and from offering or selling securities in Kansas unless those securities are federally covered or are registered or exempt from the KUSA.
