K.A.R. 40-7-26. Public adjuster; examinations. (a) The public adjuster licensing examination shall test the applicant's knowledge in the following areas:

- (1) The laws of Kansas, including the following:
- (A) The pertinent provisions of the statutes of Kansas; and
- (B) the regulations of the insurance department of insurance;
- (2) duties and responsibilities of a public adjuster; and
- (3) basic insurance knowledge.
- (b) Each applicant shall be required to score at least 70 percent on the examination, unless the applicant is exempt.
- (c) Each applicant shall be advised of eligibility to take the examination by the commissioner or the commissioner's designee, unless the applicant is exempt.
